Since 2018 Fiona McNabb has led this collaborative project that includes Lisa Thomson (Waikato District Councillor-Raglan), Bob McLeod (Raglan Community Board Chairperson), Charlie Young (Raglan Chamber of Commerce) and RCH. The project has researched the local housing situation, the impact of rising house prices on our local community, and possible solutions to accommodate all of our community. So far WRAP has produced a Research Document with the University of Waikato, and 2 Affordable Housing Forums. WRAP is supported by WEL Energy Trust.
